


## Factors that influence the frequency of urology claims<sup>1</sup>

- **1.** Number of patients diagnosed with puncture or hemorrhage
- 2. Percentage of procedures billed on a Friday
- 3. Severity of patients seen
- 4. Percentage of diagnoses for male genital issues
- **5.** Percentage of procedures billed to an ambulatory setting


#### **Top major injuries**<sup>2</sup>



#### Top allegations in urology claims<sup>3</sup>




## Indemnity for urology vs. all specialties<sup>2</sup>



#### Top contributing factors<sup>2</sup>

- **39.1%** Technical performance possible technical problem, know complication
- **23.9%** Selection/management therapy surgical/invasive procedures
- **19.9%** Failure to appreciate and reconcile relevant sign/symptom/test result
- **17.4%** Patient assessment failure/delay in ordering diagnostic test
- **13.0%** Patient factors seeking other providers due to dissatisfaction

# Clinical severity of injury for urology claims<sup>2</sup>



Low = Temporary insignificant injury or emotional only
Medium = Temporary major or permanent minor injury
High = Permanent significant, major, or grave injury
Death = Adult, child, infant, or fetal death
